

# Academic Entry Requirements by Country for Undergraduate Courses

Country	Minimum Academic Requirement: Australia Year 12 Equivalent
<b>Global</b>	<u>GCE A Level</u> with 5 points calculated on 2 or 3 A/AS level subjects. Advanced Level mark A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1. Advanced Subsidiary Level mark calculated as half of A level points. <b>OR</b> <u>International Baccalaureate Diploma</u> (IB) with a minimum score of 24 from 6 subjects.
<b>Afghanistan</b>	Successful completion of at least one year of recognised post-secondary studies.
<b>Albania</b>	Successful completion of at least one year of recognised post-secondary studies.
<b>Algeria</b>	Successful completion of at least one year of recognised post-secondary studies.
<b>Angola</b>	Successful completion of at least one year of recognised post-secondary studies.
<b>Australia</b>	Completion of Year 12. <b>OR</b> Completion of Foundation program.
<b>Bahrain</b>	Successful completion of at least one year of recognised post-secondary studies.
<b>Bangladesh</b>	Higher School Certificate (HSC) in First Division with GPA 3.5 or 60%.
<b>Bhutan</b>	Bhutan Higher Secondary Education Certificate with 80% on best 4 academic subjects.
<b>Cambodia</b>	Successful completion of at least one year of recognised post-secondary studies.
<b>Canada</b>	Canadian provincial high school certificate with 60%.
<b>Chile</b>	Successful completion of at least one year of recognised post-secondary studies.
<b>China</b>	Gao San (Senior high Year 3) with an average of 80% in four academic subjects. <b>OR</b> 高考 Gao Kao cut-off score for Tier 2 Chinese Universities. <b>OR</b> Completion of one year post-secondary study with at least an average score of 70% at a recognized institution.
<b>Colombia</b>	Completion of the first year of a Bachelor degree.
<b>Congo (Democratic Republic of)</b>	Successful completion of at least one year of recognised post-secondary studies.
<b>Fiji</b>	Year 13/Seventh Form with C or better in all subjects.
<b>Ghana</b>	West Africa GCE A Level with overall score of 10 points (refer to GCE A Level points).
<b>Hong Kong</b>	HKDSE with 15 points calculated on sum of 4 core subjects & 2 electives, where 5**=6, 5*=6, 5=5, 4=4, 3=3, 2=2, 1=1; A*=6, A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1; and Attained with Distinction = 3, Attained = 1.
<b>India</b>	Completion of All India Senior School Certificate (CBSE) or Indian School Certificate

	(CISCE) with an average of 60% in best four academic subjects*. <b>OR</b> Higher Secondary Certificate with an average of 70% (for Punjab and Haryana) or 65% (for other State Boards) in best four academic subjects* *excludes local languages, work experience, physical education and other non-academic subjects.
<b>Indonesia</b>	SMA (Sekolah Menengah Atas) with an overall average of 7.0, or GCE A-levels with passing grades in three subjects.
<b>Iran</b>	Pre-University Certificate or successful completion of the National High School Diploma with overall average of 13 (out of 20).
<b>Italy</b>	Esame di Stato with overall average of 60%.
<b>Japan</b>	Kotogakko Sotsugyo Shosho (Upper Secondary School Certificate of Graduation) with an overall average of 2.5 (out of 4).
<b>Kenya</b>	Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) with grade B in 8 subjects. <b>OR</b> Satisfactory completion of one year post-secondary study at a recognized institution.
<b>Korea (Republic of)</b>	Immumgye Kodung Hakkyo Choeupchang (Upper Secondary Certificate) with overall pass of 65%.
<b>Kuwait</b>	Shahadat Al-Thanawiya al-A'ama with overall average of 80%.
<b>Lebanon</b>	Lebanese Baccalaureate with minimum overall grade of 12.
<b>Liberia</b>	Successful completion of at least one year of recognised post-secondary studies.
<b>Malaysia</b>	Sijil Tinggi Pelajaran Malaysia (STPM) with a score of 6 points calculated on the sum of 3 subjects, where A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1. <b>OR</b> Chinese independent high school Unified Examination Certificate (UEC-SML) with a score of 12 points calculated on the sum of the best 5 academic subjects (excluding English general paper, Chinese, Bahasa Malaysia) where A1=8, A2=7, B3=6, B4=5, B5=4, B6=3, C7=2, C8=1.
<b>Mongolia</b>	Senior Middle School Graduation Certificate with average of 85% in final year results.
<b>Nepal</b>	Higher Secondary Certificate with 60%. <b>OR</b> National Examination Board (NEB) Certificate with CGPA 2.8.
<b>New Zealand</b>	National Certificate of Educational Achievement (NCEA) Level 3: a minimum of 80 credits; 60 credits at Level 3 and 20 credits at Level 2.
<b>Nigeria</b>	Satisfactory completion of one year post-secondary study at a recognized institution.
<b>Norway</b>	Norwegian Cert of Completion of Upper Secondary School Exams (Vitnemaal) with 3.0 on a 6.0 scale.
<b>Pakistan</b>	Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSC) or Intermediate Certificate examination in any stream with at least an average of 65%.
<b>Papua New Guinea</b>	Higher School Certificate with overall average of 3.0 or B.
<b>Philippines</b>	Satisfactory completion of one year post-secondary study at a recognized institution.

<b>Russia</b>	Attestat o Srednem (polnom) Obshchem Obrazovanii (Certificate of Secondary (Complete) General Education).
<b>Saudi Arabia</b>	Tawjihyah (General Secondary Education Certificate) with at least an overall average of 80%. <b>OR</b> Completion of foundation program. <b>OR</b> One year higher education program study at a recognized institution.
<b>Singapore</b>	Singapore or GCE A-levels with passing grades in three subjects.
<b>South Africa</b>	National Senior Certificate with average of 50% or GPA 4.0
<b>Sri Lanka</b>	Sri Lankan A-levels or GCE A-levels with passing grades in three subjects.
<b>Syria</b>	80% on Middle Eastern Secondary School Leaving Certificate (Al Shahada Al-Thaniya).
<b>Taiwan</b>	Senior High School Diploma or Senior Vocational School Diploma with an average of 70%.
<b>Thailand</b>	Matayom (Certificate of Secondary Education) with average grade of 80.
<b>Togo</b>	Successful completion of at least one year of recognised post-secondary studies.
<b>UAE</b>	Tawjihyya or Thanawiyya AL-A'ama (General Secondary Certificate with a minimum score of 75%.
<b>Uruguay</b>	Successful completion of at least one year of recognised post-secondary studies.
<b>USA</b>	High school diploma with average grade of C.
<b>Vietnam</b>	Bang Tot Nghiep Trung Hoc Pho Thong (Upper Secondary School Education Graduation Diploma) with an average score of 70% or 7.0
<b>Zimbabwe</b>	Zimbabwe School Examination Council: Zimbabwe GCE at Advance Level (with minimum of 2 subjects at Advanced Level (Grade E or above) AND minimum of 5 subjects passed (Grade E or above) in the Zimbabwe GCE at O level.
Other specific academic assessment for applications which are not covered above will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
